

Like all 9/11, 2001 babies, Christina Green entered this world as a ray of hope on a dark day. She loves baseball and her daddy calls her Princess. For Christmas, she asked to volunteer at a soup kitchen. At 9 she is listening to Congresswoman Gabrielle Giffords talking with constituents in Tucson, Arizona.

A deranged gunman arrives, shoots Gifford in the head, then sprays the crowd with bullets. Six people die, including Christina. Her short life was radiant with possibility, her death senseless and wrenching.

Why - nearly four years after the massacre at Virginia Tech, where 33 died, including the shooter - an obviously deranged college student can still fall so easily through the cracks, only to emerge with a gun in his hand. (reported in Time Jan. 24, 2011).

Linkin Park, on their A Thousand Suns album, sing about the tragedy of life:

When you were standing in the wake of devastation When you were waiting on the edge of the unknown And with the cataclysm raining down Your insides crying, "Save me now" You were there, impossibly alone. Do you feel cold and lost in desperation? You build up hope, but failures all you've known. Remember all the sadness and frustration... Falling into empty space With no one there to catch you in their arms.

President Obama, in his State of the Union Address said: "The dreams of a little girl in Tucson are not so different than those of our own children, and that they all deserve the chance to be fulfilled." When will such tragedies end?



The Last Message of Hope

It's interesting that 2000 years ago Jesus had something to say about these things in His last talk to His followers. In Matthew 24, speaking about end-times, He said, "Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold" (verse 12).

What sign did Jesus say would be the last to be fulfilled before the end of this world and the beginning of the next takes place? Matthew 24:14 (page 701 in NIV Bible: International Bible Society, 00195)
 And this ______will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and _____ the end will come.

The "gospel of the kingdom" is the good news that the kingdom purchased when Jesus died will be set up.

The book of Revelation is an enlargement of Matthew 24. This prophecy is expanded in Revelation 14:6-12, which is a composite of three messages symbolically given by three angels. It is known as the **three angels' messages**.

This is a call to worship the true God, the Creator of heaven and earth. God's claim for worship is based on the fact that He made us. This is the most basic fact of the Bible. The prevailing world view in the West, particularly since the 1960s, is that of secular humanism based on evolution. It holds that there is no God and that life happened by chance. Therefore, life is ultimately meaningless and "anything goes." There's no right or wrong everything is relative. This threefold message is tailor- made for our age. It presents God as Creator, Redeemer and Judge.

"Is this not the great Babylon I have built... by my mighty power and for the glory of my majesty?" Daniel 4:30

While the word **Babel** sounds like the Hebrew for "confused", in the Akkadian language it means "gateway to the gods". In building the tower of Babel the people were trying to save themselves, presumably from another flood. This is the essence of all false religions - legalism - thinking that salvation depends on something that we do. It means human-centred as opposed to God-centred religion - creature worship versus Creator worship. When **Nebudachnezzar**, **king of Babylon**, came to power (605 BC), he sought to glorify himself. He oppressed the people of God and imposed idol worship on



Examples of such religion can be found in history. The Jewish religion in the first century AD had become distorted and legalistic. The religious leaders rejected Jesus' gospel and crucified Him and then persecuted His followers (Matthew 23-28; Acts 4-8). During the first century AD the pagan Roman Empire persecuted the Christians because they refused to worship Caesar and call him lord. And again, during the Middle Ages, the church in apostasy used political power to impose a false gospel and religious system upon the then known world. The Christians who would not conform were persecuted.

So the book of Revelation uses the term **Babylon** to indicate that a similar thing will happen in the final crisis, in the antichrist's opposition to God and His people. It is a worldwide false religious coalition, composed of the dragon, the beast and the false prophet (more on this in the next Bible Guide). This is the culmination of the great controversy between Christ and Satan that has been raging since Satan, in heaven, wanted God's position (Isaiah 14:12-15, page 493; Revelation 12, page 873). Ever since sin came in, the natural human heart has wanted to take God's place and earn or merit salvation. It is a conflict that we all experience.

The "wine of her adulteries" stands for Babylon's false teachings. It's a term used of idolatry and illicit relationships of the Jews with idol-worshipping nations during Old Testament times (Jeremiah 3:8, 9, 12, 13; 4:1, 2, page 536).

Just as the good news of salvation is to go to all the world, so this Babylonian false gospel will spread around the globe (Revelation 14:8; 16:12-16; 17:1-18; 18:1-4, page 874-6).

IDOLATRY in its larger meaning is properly understood as any substitution of what is

Babylon will impose its false gospel and worship on the world and threaten with economic sanctions and death, those who refuse to conform (Revelation 13, page 873).

It reminds us of Jesus, who wept over Jerusalem and said, "How often I have longed gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing. SUMMARY OF THE THREE ANGELS' MESSAGES

The last world crisis is over true worship versus false worship - loyalty versus disloyalty, obedience versus disobedience. The entire world will be divided into two groups over the true versus the false gospel. Jesus is both our Creator and Redeemer, and the Sabbath is a memorial of both. Only those who have accepted the free gift of salvation through Jesus will be serious about following Him and honouring God's Sabbath.

THIS LAST MESSAGE OF HOPE PRESENTS GOD AS JUDGE

All major world religions have a concept of judgment. For the Hindu and the Buddhist it's karma - the law of cause and effect; for the Muslim there is a day of judgment when all humanity will be gathered and people will be judged according to their deeds. The Christian concept of judgment is that things aren't going to continue as they are forever. There's going to be a time for settling of accounts. Wrongs will be righted and justice will prevail. The gospel presupposes judgment. Someone has said: "It is impossible to preach the gospel without proclaiming judgment. To hear the story of the cross is to stand at the judgment bar of God." (See John 12:31-33, page 762).

What the gospel tells us is that we don't need to fear the judgment. The gospel is a guarantee of a verdict in our favour if we have accepted Jesus as Saviour. Paul says: "Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus" (Romans 8:1, page 800). But it also means condemnation for those who reject His free gift of eternal life.

After highlighting the heart of the gospel in John 3:16 (page 752), Jesus says: "God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son" (verses 17, 18.)

The Bible presents two groups on earth just before the second coming of Jesus: those who follow a false gospel and worship the beast (the creature) and those who follow the true gospel and worship the Creator. By our choices each day we are determining which group we will be in then.

The "Unsinkable" Titanic on

the night when the "unsinkable" Titanic sank, warning after warning had been sent to tell them they were speeding into an icefield. But the messages were ignored. The *Titanic* was talking to Cape Race about the time chauffeurs were to meet arriving passengers at the dock, and what menus were to be ready.

Preoccupied with trivia, the *Titanic* responded to the warning: "Shut up! I am talking to Cape Race. You are jamming my signals."

So confident were they of the indestructibleness of their craft that when one lady, on boarding, asked a steward, "Can this ship sink?" she was told, "Madame, God Himself couldn't sink this ship!" Such was the spirit of optimism at the turn of the century.

Archibald Brace, one of the survivors, later wrote of that fateful night when the Titanic sank:

"There arose to the sky the most horrible sounds ever heard by mortal man. The agonising cries of death from over a thousand throats, the wails and groans of the suffering, the shrieks of the terror~stricken and the awful gaspings of those in the last throes of drowning, none of us will ever forget to our dying day." (Reader's Digest)

Today, more than ever, our society is preoccupied with trivia while our world speeds to disaster. There is a new world coming (Revelation 21, 22, page 878) God wants us to be part of it. For those who heed this last message of hope to a perishing world, life's not senseless!
