

"Jesus the Living Water" Well

It's hard to imagine what it would be like to have to draw water from a well when you're thirsty rather than just turn on the tap. Jesus told the woman He met at the well that He could give her 'living water'. That meant that if she would let Him guide her life she would feel happy and satisfied. Make a well to remind you that Jesus is the One who can satisfy all our needs.

You will need:

- A shallow round container
- Pop sticks or card long enough to go around your container plus extra to make a bucket and a roof
- Coloured pencils / textas (if you are using cardboard)
- Drinking straw
- Piece of string
- Glue
- Scissors



Instructions:

- Make sure your container has no sharp edges
- If you are using cardboard cut a piece long enough to go all the way round and wide enough so it sits a few centimetres above the top of your container.
- Draw and colour bricks or stones on the cardboard piece and then stick the strip right around your container. Draw and colour a bucket to go down into your well.
- Cut two straight strips of card to act as supports for a well handle. Punch a hole in the top end end of each strip, big enough to thread a straw through. Glue these strips into the inside of your container.
- Thread your drinking straw through the holes and attach the bucket with a piece of string.
- If you are using pop sticks carefully glue them side by side all around the container
- Glue two pop sticks near the ends and stick them opposite each other, on the inside of your container.
- Cut a rectangular piece of card as wide as your container is. Fold it in half and glue to the uprights to make a roof.
- Draw a bucket out of cardboard and glue it on the side of the well.
