Guests have already been invited to join a follow-up program run by the local church. This is the time for you to contact to personally invite them. Follow-up is now passed onto the local church to continue developing the relationship and nurturing the guest towards a relationship with Jesus and with the church.

Pastor and Digital Bible Worker Meetings

First Sunday after opening weekend (this meeting will take a little longer than the others)

- 1. Gather at a pre-appointed time on a video conference.
- 2. A short prayer and devotional thought.
- 3. Use the tracking system of your choice (e.g. excel or google sheets).
- 4. The leader will go through the WHOLE list (not just guests) with the team.
- 5. Each person will share their desire to work with a guest.
 - Relationship exists already
 - Lives near them
- 6. If a person is not claimed, then the leader will assign them to a random team member.
- 7. If the person is an active member of your Church then they will not need to be followed up with.
- 8. If the guest presents themselves as an SDA member, but you are not aware of them attending, please follow up with them.
- 9. If you are aware of someone's relationship with another member please share. (cousin, nephew, friend, husband, wife, etc...)
- 10. When all guests are divided up, please make notes of your guests in the tracking system of your choice (church CRM, Google Sheets, etc.,). You may even do this as you are dividing up the guests.
- 11. After all the guests are divided please spend time in prayer over the quests.
- 12. The leader will give directions on the follow-up to take place with your new friend.
- 13. Make sure to invite even those who never showed up at the meetings.
- 14. Remind everyone of the upcoming meeting on Thursday.

Following Meetings

- 1. Gather at a pre-appointed time on a video conference.
- 2. A short prayer and devotional thought.
- 3. How did the first connection go? Did anybody respond?
- 4. Take note of any positive stories.
- Collect Questions.
- 6. Use the preferred tracking system.
- 7. The leader will go through the list with the team
- 8. Each person will share their desire to work with a viewer.
 - Relationship exists already
 - Lives near them
- 9. If a person is not claimed, then the leader will assign them to a random team member.
- 10. If the person is an active member of your Church then they will not need to be followed up with.
- 11. If the viewer presents themselves as an SDA member, but you are not aware of them attending, please follow up with them.
- 12. If you are aware of someone's relationship with another member please share. (cousin, nephew, friend, husband, wife, etc...)
- 13. When all guests are divided up, please make notes of your guests in the google sheet, disciples, or in Active Campaign. (you may even do this as you are dividing up the guests)
- 14. After all the guests are divided please spend time in prayer over the guests.
- 15. The leader will give directions on the follow-up to take place with your new friend.
- 16. Make sure to invite even those who never showed up at the meetings.
- 17. Remind everyone of the upcoming meeting.

Suggested Email Templates Copy and Paste

Make personal, by adding their name, etc and removing the (parentheses) and yellow highlights.

Sample email to send when people share a prayer request:

Dear (Guest Name),

I hope you are enjoying Hope Awakens and that John's presentations are giving you hope.

John shared with me the prayer that you submitted. I want you to know that I am praying for your request: (prayer request as well as a short personal prayer for the request).

You might want to even include a short prayer here: "Dear God, I want to pray for...

Guest Name, here's a Bible promise that's helped me through my difficult times. Share a favorite Bible promise.

Don't miss the next Hope Awakens meeting on (insert next meeting date, time and title). It's a very encouraging presentation.

Sample Email to send to someone who has asked a question:

Dear (Guest Name),

I trust you are enjoying Hope Awakens and that John's presentations are encouraging you.

I've also received your question about (summarize question). Let me help you with that.

(If John has covered the question in his presentations, then reply with the Bible verses and references he used and try to bring more clarity by explaining them. You may choose to share

additional Bible verses to answer their questions, but don't travel beyond what John has covered.

OR

If John has not covered the question in his presentation:

- 1. and they refer to questions covered in future topics (i.e. mark of the beast, sabbath or state of the dead) let them know that he will cover that on (give the date and time of the presentation)
- 2. and they are general in nature (i.e. why does God not answer my prayers or will my pet go to heaven?), then go ahead and provide Bible verses and references and brief explanations. Rely on the Bible to explain as much as possible rather than on our explanations.)
